- **No crop tops OR tank tops** (all tops must be sleeved)
- **No face paint OR costume masks**
- Shirts must be in moderate taste
- **Undergarments MUST NOT be visible**

“OWL”days Dress Up Themes:

Date	Theme	Attire
Monday, December 12	Holiday Accessories Day	Accessorize your school uniform or your spirit shirt/jeans (no rips, tears, or holes) with winter holiday socks, ties, headbands, jewelry, masks (remember no full face masks), beards, etc.
Tuesday, December 13	Holiday Movie Character Day (NO PAJAMAS ON THIS DAY! SEE FRIDAY.)	Dress up as your favorite winter holiday movie character (Elf, Rudolph, Frosty, Charlie Brown, Grinch, etc). You may also wear a winter holiday character t-shirt with jeans (no rips, tears, or holes) or uniform pants/skirt. NO PAJAMAS ON THIS DAY! SEE FRIDAY.
Wednesday, December 14	Wackiest/Tackiest/Ugliest Sweater Day	Make your own sweater or purchase one, but whichever you choose make it wacky, tacky, and ugly. You may wear jeans (no rips, tears, or holes) or uniform pants/skirt.
Thursday, December 15	Red & Green Candy Cane Lane Day	Dress in as much red and green that you can. Try your very best to look like an elf or a candy cane. NO PAJAMAS ON THIS DAY! SEE FRIDAY.
Friday, December 16	Winter Holiday Pajama Day	It’s winter holiday pajama day! You MUST wear full length pajama pants and sleeved tops. Make sure your pajama set follows the holiday spirit (red/green, plaid, snowflakes, reindeer, etc). Themed robes may be worn over dress code appropriate attire. Onsies are allowed but you MUST wear school approved shoes over the feet. NO shorts, silk, tank tops, nightgowns/slips, or slippers.
