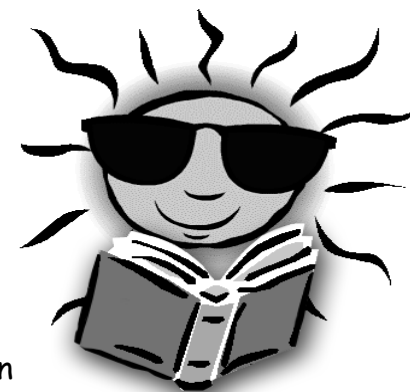


Grade 3-5 Summer Reading
